(the "Brown Act"), subject to compliance with certain requirements; 11 WHEREAS, on June 11, 2021, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-08-21, 12 providing that the modifications would remain in place through September 30, 2021; and 13 WHEREAS, on September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361, providing that 14 a legislative body subject to the Brown Act may continue to meet under modified teleconferencing rules if the meeting occurs during a proclaimed state of emergency and state or 15 local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; and 16 WHEREAS, the Local Health Officer and the Director of Mono County Public Health 17 have recommended that measures be implemented to promote social distancing, including the 18 holding of virtual meetings of legislative bodies within the County of Mono, a copy of that 19 recommendation is attached as an exhibit and incorporated herein; and 20 WHEREAS, in the interest of public health and safety, and in response to the local 21 recommendation for measures to promote social distancing, the NAME OF YOUR GOVERNING BODY] (the "Legislative Body") deems it necessary to 22 invoke the provisions of AB 361 related to teleconferencing: 23 NOW, THEREFORE, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY FINDS AND RESOLVES that: 24 25 SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are adopted as findings of the Legislative Body. 26 SECTION TWO: The Legislative Body has considered the circumstances of the State of 27 Emergency and determines that, as a result of the existence of a state of emergency related to 28 COVID-19, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees. 29 **SECTION THREE**: State or local officials have recommended measures to promote social distancing, including the holding of virtual meetings for legislative bodies within the 30 County of Mono that are subject to the Brown Act. 31
