**Mono County Board of Supervisors Approve
Contract with Bryan Bullock as Chief of Emergency Medical Services**

MONO COUNTY, Calif. (October 03, 2022) – On September 6, 2022, The Mono County Board of Supervisors approved a contract with Bryan Bullock to serve as Chief of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for Mono County.
