July 6 (E-125)	Special Districts	<p><b><i>Last day boundary maps can be presented to the Elections office (E.C. 10522)</i></b></p> <p>“At least 125 days prior to the day fixed for the general district election, the secretary of a resident voting district shall deliver to the county <b>elections</b> official of each affected county a map showing the boundaries of the district...”</p>
July 25* 3:00 pm  *suggested	District	<p><b><i>Consolidation of a Measure with the Primary election (E.C. 9140, 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 10002, 10403)</i></b></p> <p>Suggested last day to submit a resolution requesting consolidation to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) for the <b>August 9, 2022</b> BOS meeting. Resolution should include the request for the Mono County Registrar of Voters to provide services, the ballot question (75-word limit), passage requirements, the full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable), and the Impartial Analysis. The request shall be made to the BOS with a copy of the request to the Elections Official for review.</p>
Aug 12 (E-88)	District	<p><b><i>Ballot Measure (E.C. §§ 9312, 10403, 13247)</i></b></p> <p><u>Last day</u> for submission of a resolution calling a measure to the County Elections Official. The resolution shall also specify if the full text of the measure is to be printed in the Sample Ballot. The District Secretary shall deliver a resolution to the Board of Supervisors and the County Elections Official requesting that the County Elections Official conduct the election.</p>
Aug 12 (E-88)	Elections Official	<p><b><i>Transmittal of Resolution</i></b></p> <p>Elections Official transmits resolutions to the County Counsel and the County Auditor.</p>

Aug 17 (E-83)	District	<p><b><i>Last day to Withdraw a Measure (E.C. § 9605)</i></b></p> <p>Whenever a legislative body has ordered that a measure be submitted to the voters of any jurisdiction at an election, the order of election shall not be amended or withdrawn after this date.</p>
Aug 23 (E-77)	County Counsel	<p><b><i>Last day to submit Impartial Analysis (E.C. §§ 9313, 9314)</i></b></p> <p>Last day for County Counsel to submit impartial analysis to Registrar of Voters. The analysis shall be printed in the pamphlet preceding the arguments for or against the measure. The analysis is limited to 500 words.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD (E.C. § 9380)</i></b> There will be a 10-day exam period for the Impartial Analysis. The period will be held August 23, 2022 through September 1, 2022.</li> </ul>
Aug 23 (E-77)	Proponents / Opponents	<p><b><i>Last day to file arguments (E.C. §§ 9315, 9316, 9600)</i></b></p> <p>Last day set by Registrar of Voters to submit arguments in favor or against the measure. Arguments may not exceed 300 words. No more than five signatures shall appear with any arguments. Authors of Argument form shall accompany all arguments.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD (E.C. § 9380)</i></b> There will be a 10-day exam period for arguments. The period will be held August 23, 2022 through September 1, 2022.</li> </ul>
Sept 2 (E-67)	Proponents / Opponents	<p><b><i>Rebuttals (E.C. §§ 9317, 9600)</i></b></p> <p>Last day for the same authors of the primary argument to file rebuttals with the Registrar of Voters no later than 5:00 p.m. Rebuttals are limited to 250 words. Statement of Authors of Arguments form must be attached to the rebuttal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><i>PUBLIC EXAM PERIOD (E.C. § 9380)</i></b> There will be a 10-day exam period for Rebuttals. The period will be held September 2, 2022 through September 11, 2022</li> </ul>
Sept 29 (E-40)	Registrar of Voters	<p><b><i>Mail Sample Ballots and other election materials to voters (E.C. §§ 9312, 9380, 13303)</i></b></p> <p>The Registrar of Voters will begin mailing sample ballots on this date.</p>
Sept 29 (E-40)	Committees / Registrar of Voters	<p><b><i>Filing deadline for Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement (G.C. §§ 84200.5, 84200.7)</i></b></p> <p>Filing period for 1<sup>st</sup> pre-election campaign statement covers transactions from July 1, 2022 through September 24, 2022.</p>

Oct 10 (E-29)	Registrar of Voters	<p><b><i>Mail Vote by Mail ballots (E.C. §§ 3005, 3010, 3017, 3018, 3020, 4000 et seq.)</i></b></p> <p>The Registrar of Voters will begin mailing vote by mail ballots on this date.</p>
Oct 24 (E-15)	Voters	<p><b><i>Close of Registration (E.C. §§ 2106 &amp; 2107)</i></b></p> <p>Last day to register or transfer registration for this election.</p>
Oct 25 – Nov 8	Voters	<p><b><i>Conditional Voter Registration (E.C. 2170)</i></b></p> <p>Eligible persons who missed the 15-day close of registration may appear in person at the county election official's office and register and vote conditionally for this election.</p>
Oct 27 (E-12)	Committees / Registrar of Voters	<p><b><i>Filing deadline for Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Statement (G.C. §§ 84200.5, 84200.7)</i></b></p> <p>Filing period for 2<sup>nd</sup> pre-election campaign statement covers transactions from September 25, 2022 through October 22, 2022.</p>
Nov 8		<p><b><i>Election Day!</i></b></p> <p>The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m.</p>
