- Staff continues to attend the CalSTA (California State Transportation Agency) meetings on Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) implementation – nothing new to report at this time.
- Rural Counties Task Force (9/16):
 - Interim Caltrans System Investment Strategy: reviewed scoring criteria (built around SB1 & CAPTI, includes safety)
- Staff continues to meet with the MOU parties to seek potential resolutions. A verbal update will be provided at the next LTC meeting.
- Staff is pursuing transfer of STIP funds that were supposed to be received from SACOG in exchange for HIP funds but has not yet been received.
- Staff has been connecting with Yosemite National Park staff regarding SR 120 access. Yosemite National Park staff plans to attend the next LTC meeting and is working on a potential in-person meeting date in Lee Vining, weather/road closures permitting.
