2019 Mono County Community Health Needs
Assessment (CHNA), with consultants Health
TechS3, and the input from community members and
key stakeholders. The four priority areas which will be
addressed moving forward include:

- Substance Abuse
- Dental Care/Oral Health
- Behavioral Health
- Clinical Care Access/Prevention

The next step is to complete the **Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)**, which will include goals and interventions of how to improve community health in the 4 priority areas chosen.
