Californians Ages 50+ May Qualify for More Medi-Cal Benefits

There are changes coming to Medi-Cal programs for older and disabled people, which will make it possible for more people to get Medi-Cal coverage.

Beginning May 1, 2022 all California residents who are 50 years of age or older who meet all Medi-Cal eligibility criteria will be able to get full scope Medi-Cal and immigration status does not matter.

Medi-Cal has free or low-cost health care for people who live in California. Full scope Medi-Cal covers these services and more:

- Alcohol and drug use treatment
- Dental care
- Emergency care
- Family planning
- Foot care
- Hearing aids
- Medical care
- Medicine your doctor orders
- Medical supplies
- Mental health care
- Personal attendant care and other services that help people stay out of nursing homes
- Referrals to specialists, if needed
- Tests your doctor orders
- Vision care (eyeglasses)

Cerro Coso's Medical Billing Certificate Program Available at the Online Campus

This certificate provides the student with the opportunity to develop the necessary skills in the health insurance industry. The student will learn principles of medical billing related to proper claim form preparation, submission and payment processing, and the follow up process.

This certificate is recommended for anyone who is preparing for a career in a medical billing department at a physician's office, clinic, or similar positions. The student is likely to receive higher wages if certified.

Upon successful completion of the program, the student will be able to:

- Utilize software in the completion of Health Information Management (HIM) processes for billing, data collection, and data reporting.
- Evaluate the accuracy of diagnostic and procedural billing.
- Apply policies and procedures to the use of data required in healthcare reimbursement.
- Analyze current regulations and established guidelines in billing systems.

All classes needed for this certificate are available through CC Online, a virtual campus at Cerro Coso Community College, allowing for flexibility and convenience in the student's schedule.

Term Dates: June 6 to July 29, 2022 – 8 weeks Program Costs for California Residents:

- 17 units at \$46 per unit = \$782 in tuition and fees
- Plus approximately \$1,020* for books and supplies
- Total cost = \$1,802 for 2 semesters *Estimate only. Actual costs will vary.

FREE Golden Bear Pass

Did you know that any qualifying person receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI), any person receiving aid under the CalWORKS Program, or any person 62 years of age or older with income limitations is eligible to receive a free Golden Bear Pass?

The pass provides FREE day-use entry at 200+ state parks and beaches. The passes are valid from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

WORK INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT

Updated Reimbursement of 90% of Wages to Employers

Are you an employer looking for help? The specific technical skills you need may be hard to find. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) On-the-Job Training Program helps you train the right workers to meet your requirements.

This program assists employers with the costs of hiring and training new and advancing employees by offering financial reimbursement of up to 50% of the employee's wages during the training period – now updated to 90% of the employee's wages for companies with 50 or less employees.
